Vera saw the need as well and joined Marianna and Father Brenkle in that mission by making the very first donation: a \$10,000 contribution that helped establish the first Boys & Girls Club in St. Helena and charter it as part of the Boys & Girls Clubs of America system. Since then, Vera and the Trincherro/Torres family have been pillars of our organization, changing the lives of countless Up-Valley kids and families.
