

## Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When can I pick up my child from the Boys & Girls Club?

A: You may pick your child up any time before 6 pm.

Q: Will the program provide a snack for my child?

A: Members are given a free, healthy snack every day.

Q: What activities will my child participate in?

A: We're all about fun! Members regularly participate in a variety of science, art, and learning programs.

Q: When can my child get help with homework?

A: The Club offers homework assistance every day.

## WHO WE ARE

The Club opens every day when school gets out, allowing plenty of time for kids to unwind after a long day of school. It's a great time to hang with friends and grab a free snack from the Club!

Every day, the Club offers academic assistance to all members. Power Hour is entirely devoted to homework. Members are given a quiet space and supplies with staff and volunteers to help them along where needed. Staff members reinforce concepts employed during the school day and offer assistance after school, but do not check homework.

The Club is so much more than a fun place to grab something to eat and get some help with homework. We offer a full array of enrichment programs at each of our sites. Members have the opportunity to take part in a wide variety of programs and activities, from unstructured free time, to fine arts, sports, and sciences!



## WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

### Calendar & Daily Schedule

Annual Boys & Girls Club event calendars for each of our programs are available on our website at [www.BGCShc.org](http://www.BGCShc.org). Monthly program calendars are posted regularly at the site and online on our Facebook pages. These calendars are subject to change.

### Volunteerism

Parents are encouraged to take an active role in the Club as volunteers. To volunteer at the Club, adults must fill out a volunteer application and are required to submit to a background check.

### Early Release & Late Pick-Up

Parents should understand by signing their child up for the Club that they are making a commitment to have their child attend the Club regularly. The Club's schedule is designed for members to remain on site until 5:30 pm. Parents are required to pick-up their child by 6 pm. Late fees of \$1 per 1 minute per child will be charged for members left after closing. Late fees must be paid before the member(s) will be allowed to return.

### Pick Up List

Parents may designate additional friends and family members who may pick up their child in the event they themselves are unavailable. The Club recommends no fewer than four people be on the list of authorized pick ups and emergency contacts. Additional contacts may be added throughout the year.

### Who is Eligible

In order to register with the Boys & Girls Club, children must have completed their first day of kindergarten and be at least 5 years old. **Transitional Kindergartners (TK) are NOT eligible to attend the Boys & Girls Club.**

## How to Register

**Step 1:** Fill out and submit a Membership Form

- Be sure to list extra contacts
- Identify any allergy or medical issues
- Be sure to sign the form

**Step 2:** Submit a membership payment

- Make checks payable to "BGCShc"
- We also accept debit and credit cards
- Cash is also accepted but change is limited

**Things to remember**

- Keep your receipt. We can email, text or print a copy for your records
- NEVER send paperwork or payment with your child. Parents must convey this information to the Club prior to member attending.
- You WILL have to repeat this process ever summer and school year.

**Membership Fees**

- School Year: \$75 per school year per child
  - This includes school breaks
