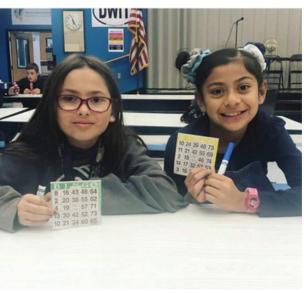

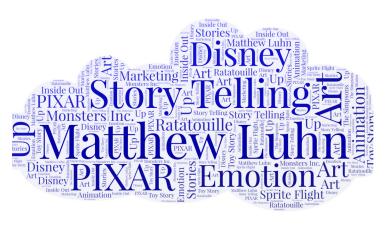

Youth Basketball

The Boys & Girls Clubs of St. Helena and Calistoga host an annual winter Youth Basketball League in Calistoga and St. Helena for boys and girls ages 6–9. With coed teams for ages 6–7 and separate boys' and girls' teams for ages 8–9, the program offers high-quality basketball development and competitive play in a fun, supportive environment.

Each year, nearly 140 youth participate in this Jr. NBA-affiliated league, receiving official jerseys they get to keep and learning valuable lessons in sportsmanship, responsibility, teamwork, leadership, and healthy living.

We aim to keep the program accessible for all families. While we've traditionally charged a \$75 registration fee per child, it costs \$18,000 annually to run the league

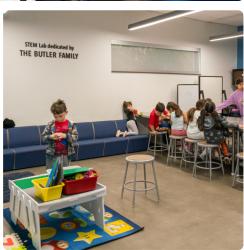
